B. Rules

- 1. Theme of this essay competition is "The Role of Asia Answering Energy and Food Crises."
 - We prefer your essay more focus on how nation or global approach react toward problems on energy and food availability. Solutions and policy recommendations for institutional viewpoint will obtain better judgment in essay scoring.
- 2. For Indonesian delegates: paper must be made individually (one person for one paper, group paper is not permitted)
 - For foreign delegates: paper can be made individually or team (max 3 persons)
- 3. Essay written in English
- 4. Submitted digitally in Microsoft Word format (.doc/.docx) and .pdf .
 - Font Times New Roman, 12, double space. Margins: top and bottom 2, 54 cm; left and right 3, 17 cm. Paper size A4.
- 5. Essay must not less than 5 pages and no longer than 10 pages. Graphs, chart, and tables included.
- 6. Essay must be original and never published before. Citations and footnotes follow standardized academic reference format.
- 7. Essay must be submitted with writer'(s) curriculum vitae in different file.

- 8. Do not put the essay on the body of the e-mail.
- 9. Essay must be sent as attachment to

economix.delegates@gmail.com

before January 7th 2009.

Every essay submitted will get an id number that will be

verified to sender's e-mail.

C. Judging Criteria

- 1. Board of Judges consists of national academician, economist, and practitioners.
- 2. Each essay will be scored as following criterion:
 - a. 5 % for grammatical structure (words usage, punctuation and etc.)
 - b. 20 % for situation and background explanation (availability of data and argument linking)
 - c. 35 % for policy recommendations of current condition and its rationality
 - d. 20 % for systematical thinking
 - e. 20 % for creativeness and argument improvisation
