Dear Prospective Applicants,

Please find the attached ESP·VSP University List for Fall 2019 Semester. Please carefully read following information regarding ESP·VSP application procedures.

1. Online Application

1) **Date: Tuesday, January 8 (10:00 am) - Thursday, January 10, 2019 (5:00 pm)**

After the application period as shown above ends, it will not be possible to log in, enter, save (submit) or modify the online application in any way. Please be aware that there is an automatic log-off function after 30 minutes from log in, regardless of idle activity. We strongly recommend that you complete the online application and list of preferred universities before noon on Thursday, January 10th to ensure that your application is complete.

- 2) **Instructions:** Yonsei Portal Service ⇒ Academic Information System ⇒ Academic Management System ⇒ **Careers** ⇒ **ESP/VSP** ⇒ **ESP/VSP Application** ⇒ **Fill out the application and Upload TOEFL score report** ⇒ Submit
- 3) Upload TOEFL Score report (for English Programs only)
 - * **Valid TOEFL test date: Test date should be after September 1, 2017.**
 - * **Incomplete application will not be accepted.**
- 4) **Transfer students** must submit one official transcript from their previous university. **Masters students** must submit official transcripts for both their undergraduate and Masters Degrees, and **PhD students** must submit official transcripts for their undergraduate, masters, and PhD degrees by email (ysoia@yonsei.ac.kr) during the application period.

2. Placement Fee for English program applicants

- 1) **Date: Tuesday, January 8 (10:00 am) - Thursday, January 10, 2019 (5:00 pm)**
- 2) **Bank Account Number: Woori Bank 126-000350-18-377 (학)연세대학교**
- 3) **Fee: KRW 10,000**
- 4) Non-English program applicants need not pay the placement fee. However, please note that students who were exempt from taking the Non-English exams, they have to pay the placement fee (10,000 KRW) during the application period.

3. Notes about the University List

- 1) **Definitions**
 - “Person”: number of individual students the host university will accept per academic year
 - “Semester slot”: available seats counted per each semester in an academic year. For example, 2 semester slots may accommodate two students, each enrolling for only one semester of study during the course of one academic year, OR one student enrolling for one academic year of study (2 semesters).
- 2) **Language**
 - English program applicants may apply to ‘영어 English’ universities in either the Language 1

or Language 2 sections.

- Non-English program applicants may apply for programs in the language of their choice in Language 1 or Language 2 sections, as indicated on the university list.

3) Semester or Year

- One semester only: Applicant must apply for one semester, and cannot apply for one year of study.
- One year only: Applicant must apply to the university for a one year program, not one semester. (This is often the case for universities observing the quarter system with three terms per academic year).
- Both: Either of the above options are available.
- **Students should confirm available areas of study, unavailable areas of study, and other restrictions for each university to which he/she will apply.** If applying for a university that doesn't have an appropriate major available, the host university has the right to refuse admission. Be sure to verify with relevant information both on the university list provided as well as the host universities' websites. Registration for any given course cannot be guaranteed under any circumstances. Plan in advance to take required courses for graduation while at Yonsei University.

4. Prerequisites and Duration of Study

1) Prerequisites

- Undergraduates: must complete at least two semesters prior to ESP/VSP application and have at least 3.0/4.3 GPA
- Transfer Students: Sophomores must complete at least two semesters at Yonsei prior to ESP application and have at least 3.0/4.3 GPA. Juniors must complete at least one semester at Yonsei prior to ESP application and have at least 3.0/4.3 GPA
- Graduates: must complete at least one semester and have at least 3.0/4.3 GPA in all programs (undergraduate, master's, and graduate)

2) Duration of Study

- **Undergraduates: The last term students may study abroad is the 7th semester. Those who begin study abroad in their 7th semester can only apply for one semester.**
- Transfer Students: Juniors must complete one semester at Yonsei in order to apply, thus may only participate in programs during the 7th semester for one semester.
- Graduates: Students enrolling in a 4-semester program can study abroad during their 3rd semester for only one semester. Students can participate in the programs only within a coursework period as implied in the regulations of each graduate school.
